» REGISTRATION **Denver**

» OVERVIEW

The CCAS SEMINAR FOR DEPARTMENT CHAIRS provides a forum in which chairs—new and experienced—can examine the art of departmental administration through close interaction with colleagues from multiple disciplines and from institutions around the country.
